Essentials

Time zone: GMT+1. The local currency is Hungarian Forint or HUF. The current (September 2004) exchange rates are: 1 USD = 204 HUF, 1 EUR = 248 HUF. Check the latest exchange rate, or rates for other currencies at <http://www.xe.net/ucc/>.

Transport Information

Arriving by Plane

Budapest airport, Ferihegy, is located 24 km (15 miles) of central Budapest. Airport information is available at www.bud.hu.

Airport Minibus

The most convenient way to get to the town from the airport is by the Airport Minibus. The Ford Transit minibuses take up to 11 passengers and take them to all destinations in Budapest. The passengers are grouped according to their respective destinations so one might have to wait until called to the bus of his/her destination area. Drivers usually speak some English. Tickets can be purchased in the Arrival Lounge at the Airport Minibus counter. Airport Minibus counters are open daily from 05.00 a.m. until 01.00.

Taxi

Avoid unmarked taxis. The following taxi companies, with logos and telephone number well marked on the side of the car, are reliable and reasonably priced. Ordering a taxi by phone is cheaper (and safer) than hailing one on the street.

Please make sure that the taxi cab has a price list (displayed usually on one of the windows). Several companies offer a fixed-price airport transfer. The fare from the airport to downtown Pest is about HUF 4,000 to 5,000.

Public transport

There is a bus departing from the airport every 30 minutes and arriving at the Kispest subway stop (Blue line M3). The bus stop is located outside the airport building between terminals A and B. Local coins are needed to buy a ticket from the vending machine. The ticket price is about 1 EUR.

Arriving by Train

Budapest has direct railway connections to 16 European capitals. All international trains have a dining car and a sleeping car or compartment. Most international express trains arrive at and depart from Keleti Central Railway Station.

Links between Railway Stations

Déli and Keleti railway stations are connected by the M2 (red) underground (7 stops). Nyugati railway station too can be reached from Déli and Keleti railway stations by underground. Take the M2 underground from Déli railway station (4 stops) or from Keleti railway station (3 stops) to Deák Square, then take the M3 (blue) underground in the direction of Újpest városközpont 2 stops to Nyugati Railway Station. (Note: In Hungarian, "railway station" is "pályaudvar".) Metro tickets are sold in the ticket office at the Metro entrance.

M3: Budapest - Gyöngyös - Polgár (provides access to Slovakia; sections beyond are under construction)

M5: Budapest - Kiskunfélegyháza (parts towards Szeged and the southern frontier under construction)

M7: Budapest – Siófok

Motorways are toll roads and can only be used with prepaid vignettes (“matrica” in Hungarian). Vignettes are sold at large gas stations and at main post offices.

Vignette tariffs for motorcycles, cars and caravans (vehicles until the weight of 3.5 tones):

4-day vignette:	1.270 HUF
10-day vignette:	2.000 HUF
31-day vignette:	3.400 HUF
1-year vignette:	30.500 HUF

Local Transportation in Budapest

The Public Transportation Pass is valid for all subways, trams, and buses within the area of Budapest. Passes can be purchased at almost all subway stations at the ticket office.
